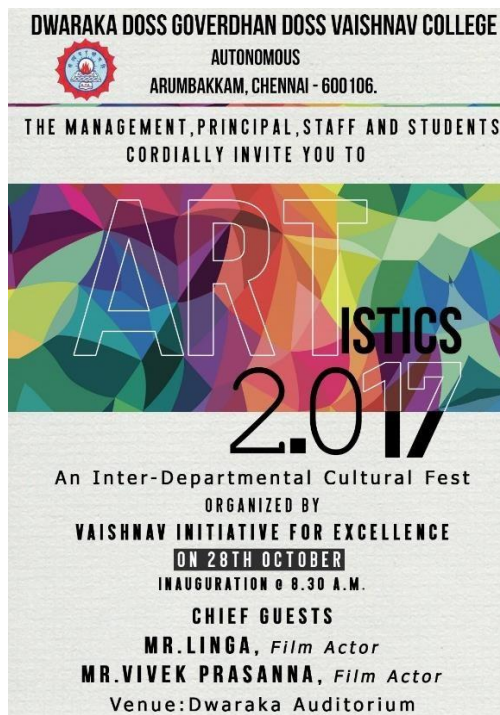
9. Detailed Report:

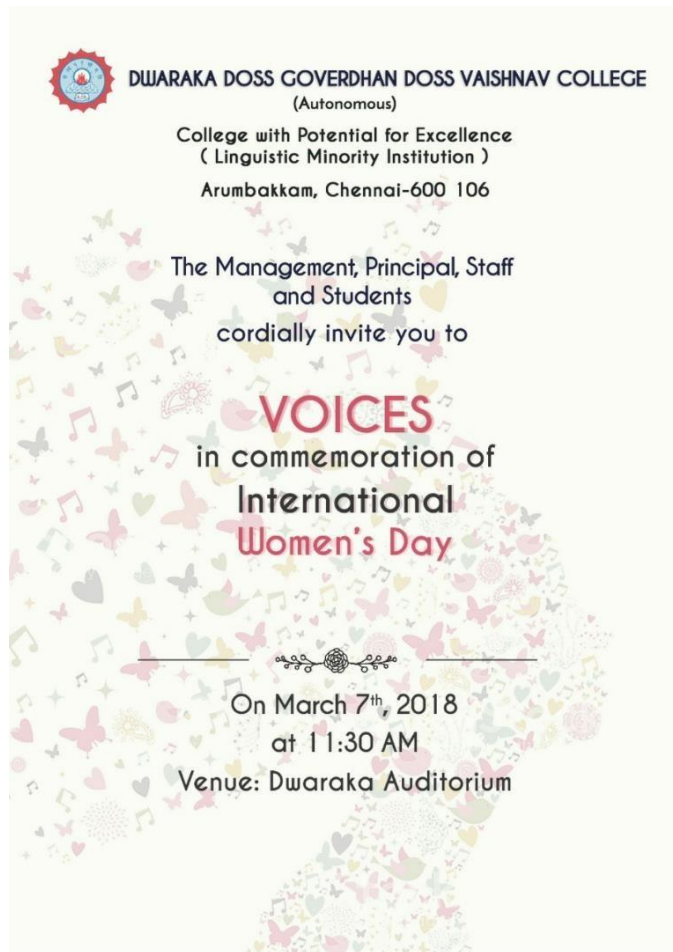
