The college made its humble beginning in the year 1964, founded by the Vallabhacharya VidyaSabha with Shri Totadri Iyengar as the first Principal. The institution was established with the Noble vision of benefitting youngsters desirous of pursuing higher learning with quality education and wisdom.

In the year of its inception, the college offered a degree course in Mathematics along with pre-university courses. The very next year degree courses in Physics and Economics were introduced. 





The Central library has an exhaustive collection of textbooks along with reference books, theses, journals, magazines, newspapers, question paper banks, etc, The library is also equipped with online database.


Department Library


