Extensive use and misuse of antibiotics means that their effectiveness has waned. This is fast becoming a major public health crisis. The permanent threat of emerging pathogens calls for vigilance, surveillance and preparedness for vaccine development and deployment. Vaccines are the cornerstone of the management of infectious disease outbreaks and are the surest means to defuse pandemic and epidemic risk. The faster a vaccine is deployed, the faster an outbreak can be controlled.
