NDLI Connect: Awareness Programme and Registration Drive 23.07.2024



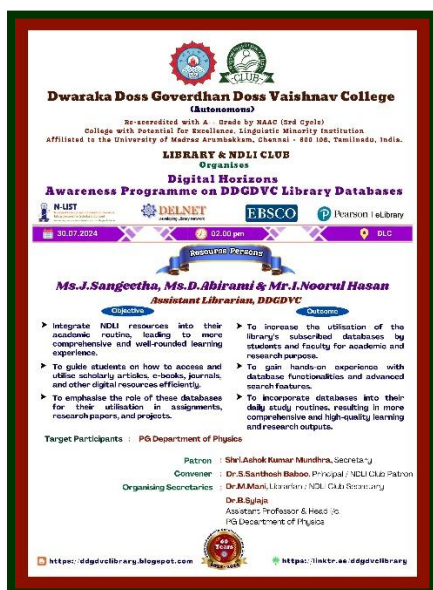
Report:

Workshop on “Design Your Poster & Website: Harnessing Free Online Tools” 22.08.2024



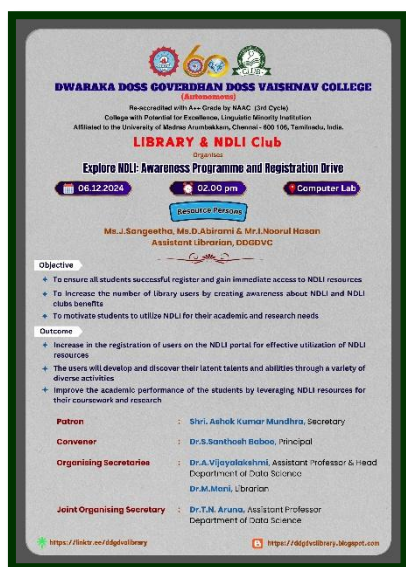
Report:

Intra Collegiate Photography Competition 30.01.2025



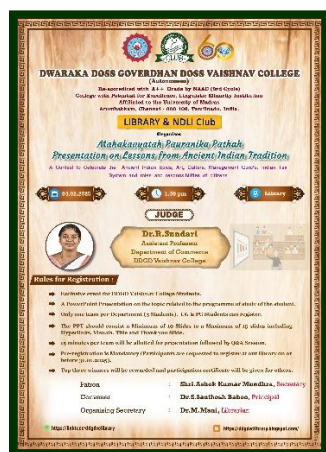
Report:

Mahakavyatah Pauranika Pathah Presentation on Lessons from Ancient Indian Tradition 04.02.2025



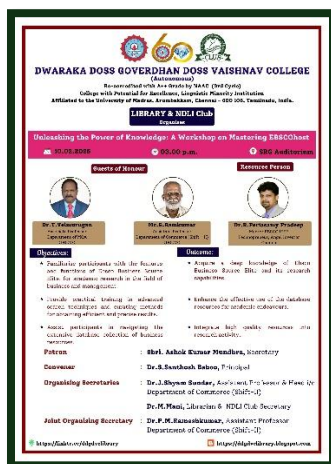
